

Daily departures to Maasai Mara - the 7th wonder of the world considered to be the **Greatest animal show on earth!**



he Mara offers wildlife in such variety and abundance that it is difficult to believe: over 450 species of animals have been recorded here. You will easily see lions, rhinos, hippos, crocodiles, giraffe, wildebeests, zebras, buffalo, warthogs, hyenas, jackals, wild dogs, buffalo, leopard, many kinds of antelopes and elephant. It is in the Mara that perhaps the most spectacular event of the natural world takes place. This is the annual migration of millions of wildebeest and zebra from the Serengeti (Tanzania) in search of water and pasture. Following on their heels are the predators of the savanna- lion, cheetah, wild dog, jackal, hyena and vultures

Day 1: Nairobi – Maasai Mara

After breakfast depart for Maasai Mara to arrive at Maasai Mara in time for lunch.

Afternoon game drive till dusk. Dinner and overnight at your Olmorán Tented Camp

Day 2: Maasai Mara

Full day in Masai Mara. After breakfast leave for full day game drive to a home to over 3million large mammals. Our game drive takes us to searching the animals which include Lion, Leopard, Buffalo, Elephant, Rhino, Hyena, Cheetah, Jackal, warthog, giraffe, zebra, antelope and many different bird species. Picnic lunch will be served at Mara River. Dinner & overnight at Olmoran Tented Camp

Day 3: Maasai Mara – Nairobi

After breakfast leave camp/lodge with game viewing enroute for your return journey to Nairobi.
